REACTING TO ISSUES

The proper procedure if there are issues which affect a game is to:

1. At the first break in the game draw the referees attention to the matter,
2. If that fails seek the intervention of the person in charge of the venue. (that could be a referee's supervisor, a games supervisor or the doorkeeper).
3. If that fails warn that complaints will be lodged through your association and then follow up through your association.

Unilateral aggressive action always worsens any situation and may lead to reports.

Coaches and other team officials/spectators must not address players from the opposition team.

Any complaint about conduct of opposition players must be directed to the referees, or the opposition coach or team manager.
