ABANDONED GAMES RULE

(Just in case – we certainly wish to avoid abandoned games – delay is better, but do not play if conditions are unsafe).

“Any game abandoned due to unforeseen court difficulties shall be resolved as follows:

- Any game terminated during the first half shall be replayed unless by mutual agreement the teams agree to the result being accepted as final.
- Unless written notification of disagreement is received, any game terminated (abandoned) in the second half, shall have the result at the termination accepted as final.

REVIEWS

12 East 2 Boys continued its reputation as a close grade. Warrandyte (2) won their first game by one point against a team in the top five.
