How Head to Head Works

If two teams A & B finish equal on points it is simply a matter of the results of those teams against each other. If A won both times A is ahead of B. If they each won a game, then the team which won by the bigger margin will be ranked higher.

In the case of three teams finishing equal on points it is the win/loss ratio of those teams in the games against each other which are the first point of ranking. So consider the results A def B twice, A & C one win each, B & C one win each. Ranking would be A 3 wins highest, C 2 wins 2nd rank, B one win 3rd rank.

If the teams end up with two wins each between each other then it is the margins in the six games that count, so that the team with the highest percentage from the four games within that trio of teams is ranked first and so on.
