## TOP FIVE AND TOP EIGHTS

Teams should make sure of the system of the finals they are playing, indicated by the ladders on the website.

In the first week of the EIGHT TEAM SERIES it is 1v4, 2v3, 5v8 and 6v7. Winners of 1v4 and 2v3 obtain a rest the following week. The losers of 1v4 and 2v3 play the winners of 5v8 & 6v7.

In the first week of FIVE TEAM SERIES it is 2v3, 4v5. The top team has a bye. The following week the winner 2v3 plays first; loser of 2v3 plays winners of 4v5.

## GIRLS GRADES

12 East 2 Frankston (6) improved their chances of making the finals by defeating Western Port (2) (3<sup>rd</sup>).

14 East 1 Sandringham (4) and Frankston (5) kept hopes alive with wins.
